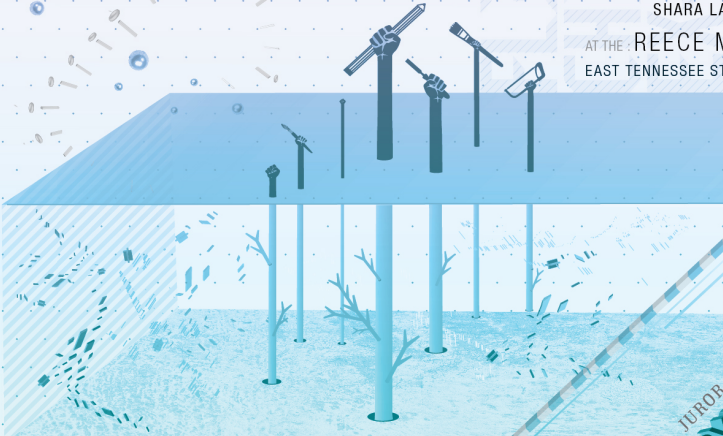

We are pleased to announce a Guest Artist Presentation by Shara Lange, Program Head & Assistant Professor, RTVF, ETSU. Shara K. Lange is founder and director of Light Projects: Documentary/Art/Community and completed her MFA in film production at the University of Texas at Austin's Radio/TV/Film department. Her thesis film, *The Way North* (Student Academy Award Regional Semi-Finalist) tells the story of North African immigrant women in southern France. She was awarded a Fulbright Fellowship to make the documentary, *THE Dressmakers* (currently in post-production). She has worked on various film projects including *Habitat Media's, Empty Oceans, Empty Nets* and *Steven Okazaki's, Rehab*.
